### BREAKFAST CLUB PROVISION

### RAILWAY SAFETY

We would like to alert parents/carers to the upcoming works taking place on the nearby railway line. From 28 July 2024 the overhead power lines suspended above the track from Kettering station to South Wigston station will be energised and will remain energised. The overhead line will be energised at 25,000 volts, alternating current at 50Hz frequency. It is extremely dangerous for any person to be in close proximity (9ft) of the equipment, including supporting masts, switch feeds and cables.

There is of course no danger to any persons provided they do not enter onto railway land (and are always more than nine feet from the overhead lines).

Please speak to your child/children about the importance of railway safety.
