BREAKFAST CLUB PROVISION

Breakfast club is open to all children every day, from 7.30am. The club runs from 7.30am - 8.35am at a cost of £4 per session. Children can be dropped off at any point within this time slot and a light breakfast is offered to the children. If you wish to book a session, please phone or email the office by 3.30pm the day before you require care at the latest. Payments will need to be paid in advance, cash only, before the date of the session. Please hand all payments to the school office or the staff member leading the breakfast club.

We are also happy to be able to continue the 'ad-hoc' booking system where families can pick and choose their requirements and book up to the day before the session, which we know is a big hit with families.
